6 **CAASPP-** Data has been compiled by the County. The attached graphics show how that data correlates in specific equity groups throughout the school and how our scores compare to those of the rest of the county and the state.

Benchmark Assessments- Tabled until December meeting.

Discipline Data- Discipline referrals increased steadily since 12-13. We are in the process of implementing PBIS to reduce referrals and allow students to manage expected behaviors on their own.

California Healthy Kids Survey- The attached data shows how kids feel about school and experiences they've had in regards to health choices and mental well-being.

Social/Emotional Supports- We have many supports for Gerber students. Mr. Cheatham reported to Ms. Marr we are servicing at least 100 students for social/emotional needs.

Our District Goals were distributed to members, these outline how we plan to meet the goals set forth in our LCAP and what services will accomplish that.


