3 Our new consolidated goals will be:

- 1) Student Achievement
- 2) Engagement/Parent Involvement/School Culture
- 3) Facilities

M/S/C Spending Priority List

4 We need to project out our funding through 2017-2018. Our funding for each goal was discussed as follows:

- 1) **Student engagement-** We would like to continue current funding through 2017-2018 for curriculum, technology, professional development, RTI program (including expanding RTI services to two teachers as funding permits), ELD program (including expanding ELD services to 1.5 teachers as funding permits), Technology Teacher, NEU program, and TK program.
There was a discussion about the potential of the CDS program being revamped into some sort of behavior support program that would accommodate more students and allow for an increase to discipline flexibility.
- 2) **Engagement/Parent Involvement/School Culture-**We would like to continue current funding through 2017-2018 for Psychologist/Counselor, Rusty May, Rachel’s Challenge, assemblies, and Royal King Dance. We would keep our current lunch program as we gather data on the changes that have been implemented in the menu and recess before lunch.
We would like to fund a 1.0 FTE Music Teacher starting in 2016-2017 if funding permits, if not then start with a part time teacher.
For PE we will look into a program/curriculum to be implemented by the teachers.
Our 2 day/week counselor and 5 day/week social worker grant is funded through 2016-2017. We will need to allocate our own funds beginning in 2017-2018 if we wish to continue those services. It was discussed that we could roll those two positions into one full-time position when we begin funding it.
We will continue with our current notification system, parent outreach activities (newsletters, BTSN/Open House, etc.), Parents’ Club, and advisory committees (ELAC/DELAC, SSC, etc.)
- 3) **Facilities-** There was no mention above and beyond our current expenditures that provide facilities that are adequate and maintained in good repair. The majority of this is outlined under the Williams Act and Ed. Code.

We did discuss a gymnasium, but are hoping to be able to get that grant funded in the future.
