HEALTHY SNACKS, FOOD & TREATS

In 2006 Gerber Union Elementary School District adopted a Wellness Policy on Physical Activity and Nutrition. I would like to provide you portions of what the Wellness Policy states in an effort to promote healthy foods being brought to school by parents and staff. Please help us assure all children at Gerber School have access to healthful foods and opportunities to be physically active in order to grow, learn and thrive.

Rewards: Schools will not use foods or beverages as rewards for academic performance or good behavior, and will not withhold food or beverages (including food served through school meals) as a punishment.

Celebrations: Schools should limit celebrations that involve food during the school day to no more than one party per class per month. Each party should include no more than one food or beverage that does not meet nutrition standards for foods and beverages. The district will disseminate a list of healthy party ideas to parents and teachers.
